The following is the Emery Unified School District's plan for offering transportation services to its students pursuant to the requirements in Education Code Section 39800.1.

Transportation Services:

1. Enter description of transportation services offered to pupils, and how it will prioritize planned transportation services for pupils in transitional kindergarten, kindergarten, and any of grades 1 - 6 inclusive and pupils who are low income. Emery Unified School District has a no-cost Student Transit Pass Program (STPP) for our students in grades TK-12. This program is in partnership between the school district and AC Transit. Students or parents/guardians can apply online at <https://www.alamedactc.org/programs-projects/studentpass>. The District will offer AC Transit bus passes to the guardians of any students in grades TK-5 who qualify for free or reduced-price meal.

2. Enter description of LEA's transportation services that would be accessible to pupils with disabilities, and homeless children and youth.

The District ensures that appropriate transportation services are provided for students with disabilities as specified in their individualized education program (IEP) by contracting the ridership through the District's approved transportation providers and mileage reimbursement for parents who choose to transport their students. In addition, the District offers transportation services in the form of no-cost transit passes to homeless and foster students.

3. Enter description of how unduplicated pupils, would be able to access available home-to-school transportation at no-cost to the pupils.

Unduplicated students can access transportation services at no cost if transportation services are specified in a student's IEP. They may also gain transportation services at no cost if the student has been identified by Administration as an unduplicated student needing transportation services and/or no-cost transit passes. Unduplicated students are students who are eligible for free or reduced-price meals, homeless, and/or foster youth.
